PWN Chapter Organization

- Minimum Requirement: Have a Chair or Co-Chair
- Other leadership roles depend on local interests
 - Possible positions: Vice Chair, Secretary, Social Media Editor, Service Project Coordinator, Happy Hour Organizer, Book Group Leader, Etc.
- Plan and Host One or More Events a Year
 - Events depend on local interests and vary across the world
