

Steps to Plan a Celebrate Princeton Pride Event

- Recruit a local organizer(s) and/or host(s)
- Secure a venue
- Host(s) should connect with regional association presidents to coordinate event timing and event promotions (website, newsletters, emails, social media)
- Utilize Alumni Engagement/University Resources
 - Request a free Party Pack
 - Request a CORA/QPA financial assistance grant
- Promote your event in collaboration with local regional association
- Don't forget to:
 - Have fun!
 - Talk up the Every Voice conference
 - Take pictures and share with CORA & QPA



Celebrate Princeton Pride Party Pack Request Form




- Request a free Party Pack via this Google Form no later than:
 - Three weeks before your event for international shipping
 - Two weeks before your event for domestic shipping
- Party Pack includes:
 - Generic Princeton branded items (sticky name tags, balloons, cocktail napkins, etc.)
 - CPP pins
 - LGBTQ+ flags
 - Every Voice conference coasters



CORA + QPA Grants for Celebrate Princeton Pride Events

- Apply for a financial assistance grant using the Google Form:
 - Up to \$200 is available for gatherings of 10-25 attendees
 - Up to \$300 is available for gatherings of 26+ attendees
 - Maximum award is \$300
- To receive grant funds:
 - Host event
 - Complete <u>Guest Reimbursement</u> <u>Form</u>
 - Provide food + beverage receipt(s)
 (within 1 month of your event)
 - Share 1-2 event photo(s)





Celebrate Princeton Pride Event Promotion Best Practices

- Collaborate with regional association leadership to promote your event throughout the local community:
 - Email (TigerNet)
 - Regional Affairs staff can provide suggested event invite/email copy
 - Regional Website
 - Regional social channels
- Available graphics: transparent and white backgrounds
